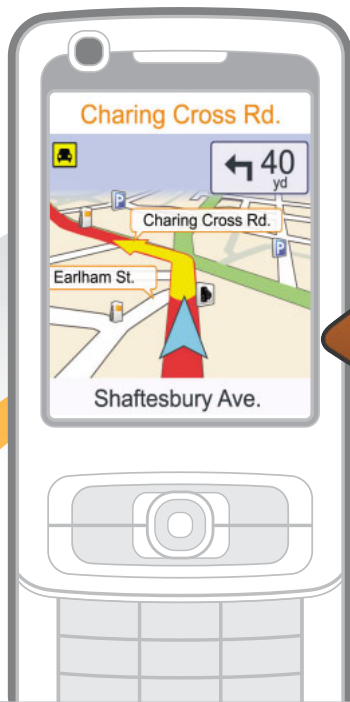

Orange Maps

sat nav on your phone



map and navigation all on your phone

Orange Maps is your complete personal navigation system that stays with you wherever you are. Benefits include:


- turn by turn GPS guidance with 3D maps and voice instructions that announce street names. Orange Maps Professional also includes real time traffic updates and speed camera alerts.
- on foot Orange maps can find pedestrian routes, for the urban navigator.
- full Ordnance Survey post code search. Easy to search locations and points of interest.
- full local search capabilities including millions of points of interest (restaurants, bars, hotels etc.).
- fast and accurate search results even from misspelt or partial input.
- call points of interest directly from Orange Maps and send the location via SMS to friends and colleagues.

find a place and navigate



To start Orange Maps click this icon  in the application menu. Read and accept all the prompts and safety messages to get to the Orange Maps main menu.



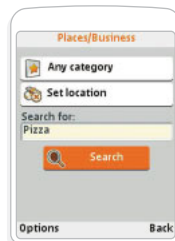
From the Orange Maps main menu, open the **Where to** option to view different options to set your destination.

You can even navigate directly to the contacts stored in your phone address book by choosing **Contacts**.

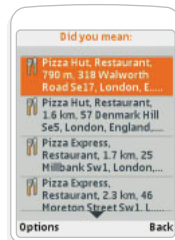


To look for a **street address** or post code, just fill in the search fields. For the City and Street fields, entering the first 2 or 3 letters for lookup is usually enough. Even if you misspell, Orange Maps will usually find what you are looking for.

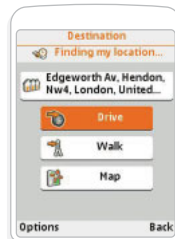
In order to find your location, make sure that your phone or Bluetooth GPS has a clear view of the sky. The first time you use Orange Maps this may take several minutes.



To look for a place or business, click on **Directories** in the main menu and just enter the name in the **Search for** field. For example, you can enter "Big Ben" or "Pizza". You can also narrow your search by defining the location of your search or a category.



Select your destination from the displayed list of results.

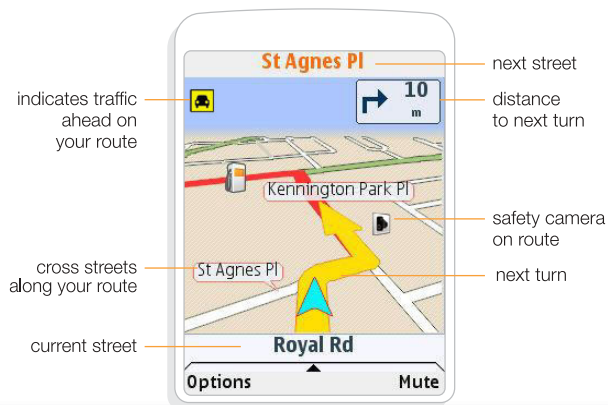


Select **Drive** if you are using a car, or **Walk** for a pedestrian route.

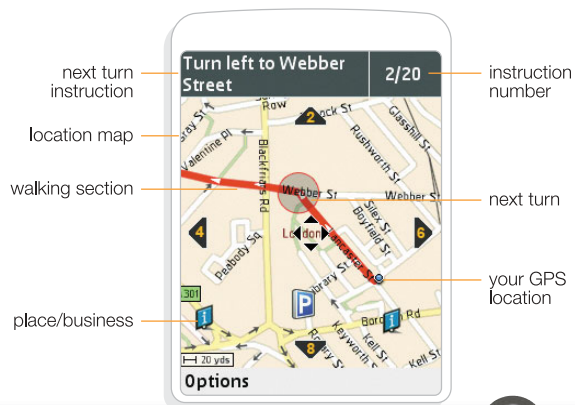
Orange Maps will calculate the route and then guide you from your current location or another selected starting point to your destination.

You can also select **Map** to view a map of your destination.

walk with Orange Maps



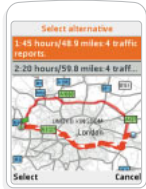
Don't forget - always Orange Maps in a car with hands-free kit.



You can easily zoom by pressing Options and choosing **zoom**.

If your position is known, it will be displayed on the pedestrian navigation maps. You can switch maps along your route by selecting **Next** from the Options menu even if you don't have GPS coverage.

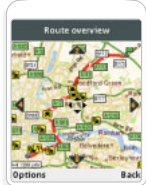
live traffic and safety camera information



If there is heavy traffic on your route and there's a reasonable alternative, Orange Maps may offer you the two routes to choose from. Simply select your preferred route to start navigating.



By selecting, **Options | Traffic report**, or pressing 7 you can view a detailed list of any delays along your route. For each delay you can see its cause, location, and how long you could be held up for.



Any map you view will show all traffic delays in the displayed area.

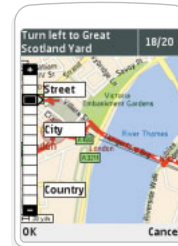
Simply select **Options | Traffic report** on this map view for a detailed list of traffic delays.



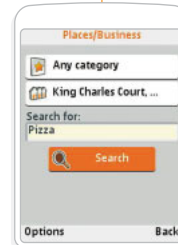
The Navigation screen displays icons to indicate traffic or safety cameras along your route where this information is available. If traffic changes or a better route becomes available, Orange Maps will let you choose between your current route and the new one.

*Real time traffic updates and speed camera alerts are only available with Orange Maps Professional package.

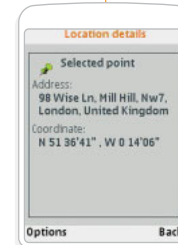
mapping



When viewing a map you can explore your surroundings by moving the map cursor. To move the map, move the cursor beyond the edge of the screen or use the 2, 4, 6 and 8 keys. Select **Options | Zoom** to display the zoom bar and change the scale of the map.



You can perform a local search for places and businesses directly on the map. Simply select **Options | Find nearby**.



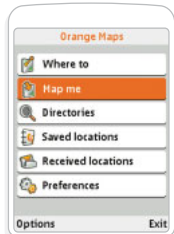
Click the selection key to get more details about a selected point on the map.



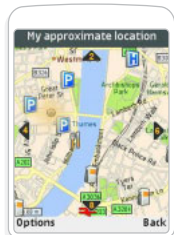
Select **Options | Select location** to navigate directly to the selected point on the map.

local search and mapping without GPS

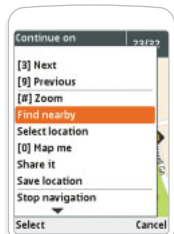
If you do not have GPS coverage (e.g. you are indoors) you can still map your location or search for nearby places and businesses.



To view a map of your location, even if you do not have GPS coverage, select **Map me** from the **Main Menu**.

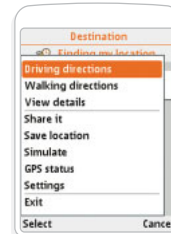


Your location is displayed as a circular region to indicate that it is approximate. The accuracy can vary depending on where you are and whether or not you can get a GPS position.

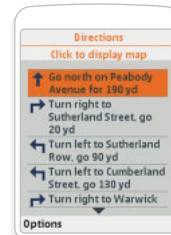


To search for a Place or Business in your area select **Find nearby**.

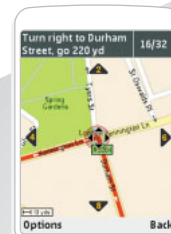
previewing a route



After setting your destination, you can preview a route by selecting **Driving directions** or **Walking directions** from the **Options menu**.



The preview is displayed as a list of instructions with an icon to indicate the turn direction.



Scroll to any instruction and select it to view a map of that instruction. You can continue to scroll through maps of the instructions by selecting **Next** and **Previous** from the menu.

frequently asked questions

How is Orange Maps different from traditional in-car navigation systems or out-of-the box units?

Orange Maps runs on your mobile, so it is always with you wherever you go. You'll always get the latest maps and points of interest (restaurants, bars, hotels etc.) because they are stored centrally on our network and sent to your phone each time you plan a journey.

Am I connected to the mobile internet all the time while Orange Maps is running?

You connect to the mobile internet to download map data when you first plan the route. The application will then disconnect. Orange Maps will reconnect periodically for traffic updates or for route updates if you deviate from the planned journey.

Can I continue to make and receive calls while using Orange Maps?

Yes, but each device behaves differently. You can usually accept a call in the normal way you are used to, for example, by simply pressing the green key. To make a call you can try minimizing Orange Maps by pressing the device Menu key or the End key.

What happens if I leave a route during navigation?

For small deviations from the route, Orange Maps reacts instantaneously and simply continues to give you instructions that guide you to your destination. For larger deviations from the

route Orange Maps will automatically connect to the mobile internet and calculate a new route from your current location.

Why does my GPS status switch between “Position Fix” and “Finding my location”?

Your GPS requires direct visual contact with the GPS satellites in order to receive signals and correctly determine your position. A number of factors can interfere and cause your GPS to momentarily lose its position fix. Some of these factors include:

- Metallic materials like the roof of a car that may block signals
- Narrow streets between tall buildings that reduce the field of view of the receiver
- Glass surfaces that can sometimes lead to reflections of the satellite signals, impairing the receiver's performance
- Dense foliage can hinder reception due to the water in the leaves

How do I save a location if I want to use it again?

Any location you have used recently can be found in the list of “Recent locations”. For more permanent storage you can save any location to “Saved places”. Simply highlight the location and select “Save” from the Orange Maps menu.

personalise your Orange Maps

You can personalise Orange Maps by configuring several settings according to your preference:

Route preferences

- Optimise the route calculation for **fastest** or **shortest** route
- Set the application units to be **Km, meters** or **Miles, yards**
- Check the POI Display box to display route relevant points of interest in the navigation screen
- Check one of the “**avoid**” options if you want the route calculation to try and avoid **toll roads, motorways** or **ferries**

Traffic alternatives

- Check the **When navigation starts** box if you want to receive traffic-aware alternatives for your route before you set out
- Check the **During navigation** box if you want Orange Maps to check for better traffic alternatives during navigation

On route

- Check the **Speed camera alerts** box to receive notifications when you approach speed cameras (where data is available)
- Check the **Say street names** box if you want the sound instructions to include street names

Backlight

You can set the device backlight to always be on during navigation or behave according to the current device settings.

Volume

You can set the application volume for sound notifications.
